

Assignment: iReporter
Due: Tuesday January 16

For this assignment you will document an event with your cellphone camera. (If you do not have a cellphone camera – you may use any digital point and shoot available).

You can document the event of your choosing – it can be a formal or informal event, or even an unplanned gathering.

PART 1:

Take at least 15-20 images from the event. After the event, go through your images and pick the best 3 images that work together to show the event to the viewer.

Email the best 3 images to yourself at your MSU email address so the images will be accessible to you in the lab classroom on January 16. Do not resize the images – send them full size!

All images must be focused. Do not submit blurry images.

Once you have the images selected – create an event title and write an explanatory paragraph in the email that summarizes the event. This paragraph should describe the event to a viewer that was not in attendance. Also, consider augmenting the information available in the photographs.

Have the email ready to access at the beginning of class January 16.

PART 2:

These will be formatted in class January 16. There will be a demonstration on the proper formatting technique in class.

We will be using the application Bridge to organize the images within a folder and add your written information to the metadata of the digital images.

We will format these in class and turn in the completed folder via file-sharing to the class dropbox.
