Pick a tutorial and email me (wroussin@comm.msstate.edu) with your choice by midnight Friday February 16. Consider sending a back-up tutorial choice as well. Be sure to pick a technique that clearly involves manipulation of the image(s). I will send back approval or denial by Sunday February 18.

You may also search the web for a Photoshop CC tutorial on your own but must email me by midnight Thursday February 15 (24 hours before regular deadline) in case your idea is not acceptable.

Once approved, you will need to prepare a completed tutorial demonstration for the class. This tutorial should take approximately 10 minutes to explain and demonstrate. Your tutorial may contain links to sample image files – if not, please prepare your own files for the demonstration (if your tutorial does contain sample files – you will receive extra credit for creating your own sample files).

Prepare a 1-page minimum handout for your demonstration. At a minimum, you should have a 1-2 paragraph description (don't plagiarize – use your own words) of your technique and a bullet list of steps. (A PDF is preferred for easy linking)

Your classmates will complete an assessment handout during your presentation.
