EXERCISE 2

Grading criteria will be a mix of technical skill (required elements) and aesthetic concerns (fonts, sizes, colors, etc...)

Open TextWrangler and create a new document, saved as "ex2.html". You may need to add the ".html" manually. Make sure you save this index.html in the "exercises" folder of your local web folder.

Review my sample page, the Tables handout, and other handouts for proper coding structure.

In the <head> section:

- Set the page title as: Your Name | Exercise 2 | Tables
- Set the following CSS attributes
 - "body, td, th" for font family, size and color
 - "body" for background color and margins (use at least 20 pixels for margins)
 - "a:link, visited, hover, & active" for link colors, font weights, and decoration
 - Create Heading tags as needed (h1, h2,...)

In the <body> section:

- Create a h1 header for the page:
 - Your Name
 - Exercise 2: Working with Tables
- Use an h2 heading for the Table labels. (Table 1, Table 2, Table 3)
- Determine the correct code and create the following tables. Pay attention to alignment and spacing.
